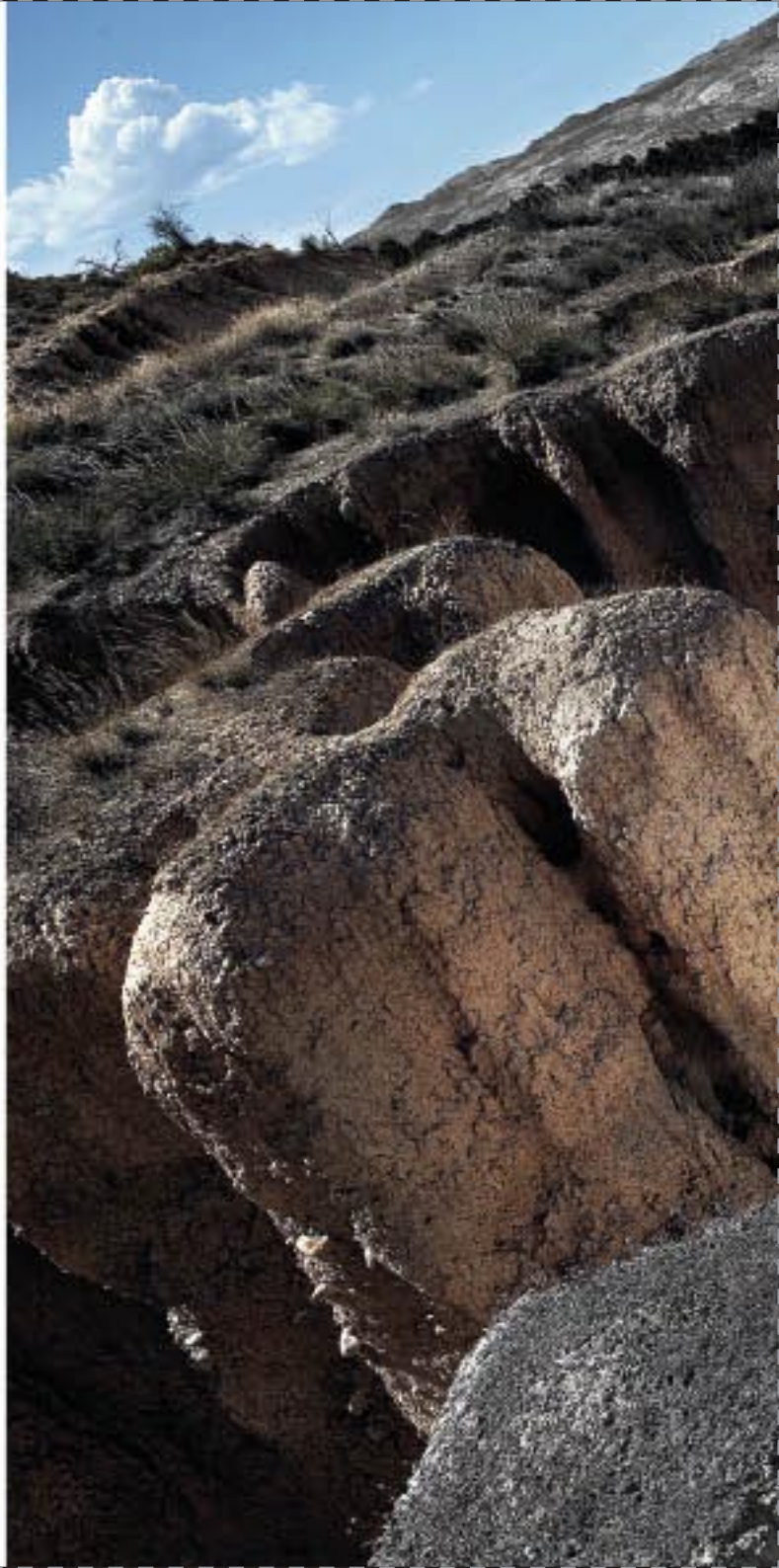

It's a totally dual-purpose motorcycle with rider-friendly torque, long-travel suspension, aluminium swingarm (for reduced unsprung weight and better handling) and low 206 kg weight for an all-round better ride, whether you're tarmac cruising or off-road exploring. The 23-litre fuel tank, comfy dual seat, vertically stacked twin headlights, easy-to-replace body protector panels and trick rally-raid styling complete the go-anywhere spec. XT660Z Ténéré; it's the art of adventure.

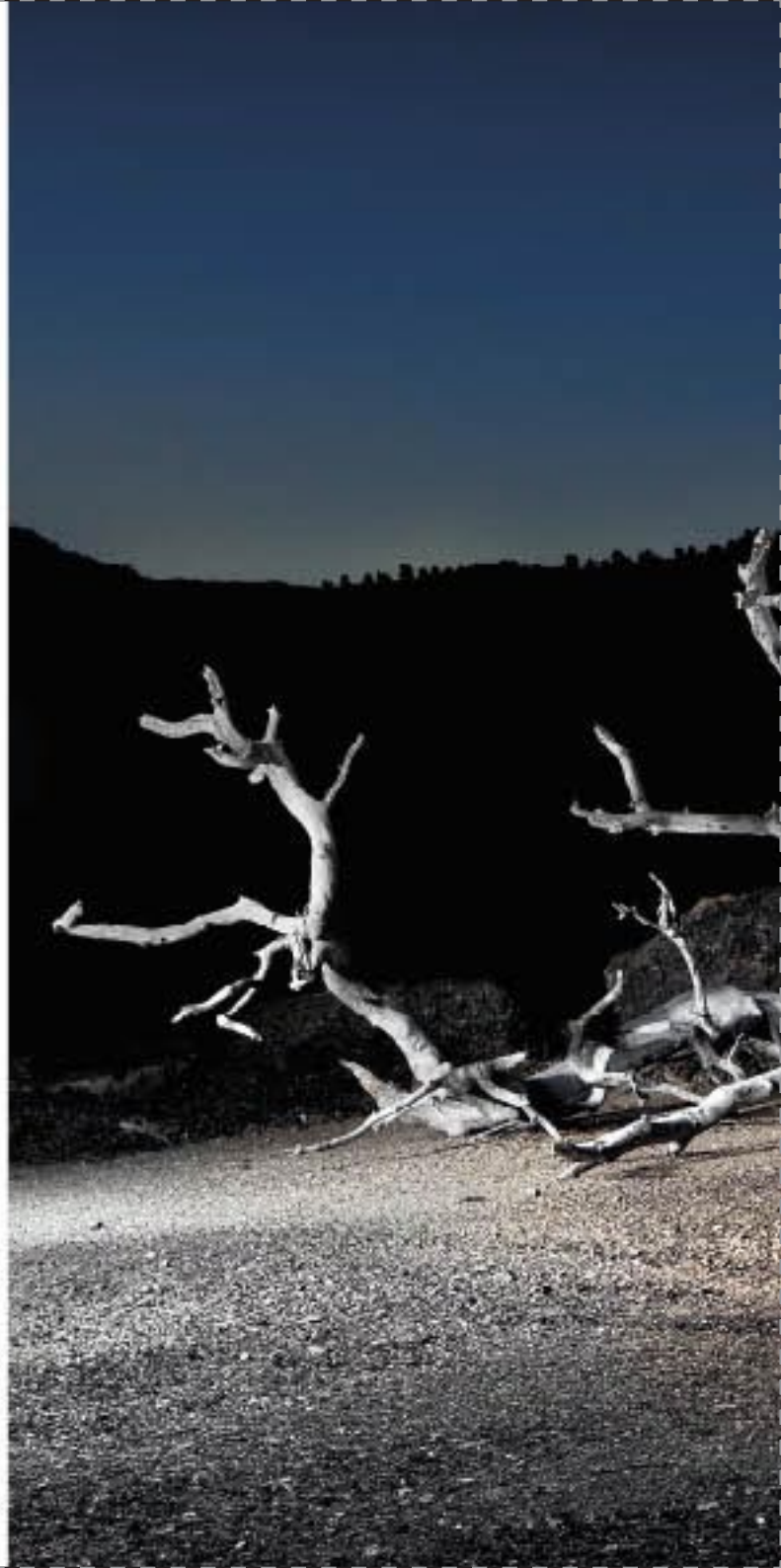

The steel diamond frame is built for toughness, with long-travel telescopic front forks, 21-inch front wheel, Monocross rear end and knobby tyres that handle city cobbles and rough farmyard tracks. The XT660R is a totally practical motorcycle but it's got the look too, with rugged motocross styling and high-level, upswept exhaust mufflers.

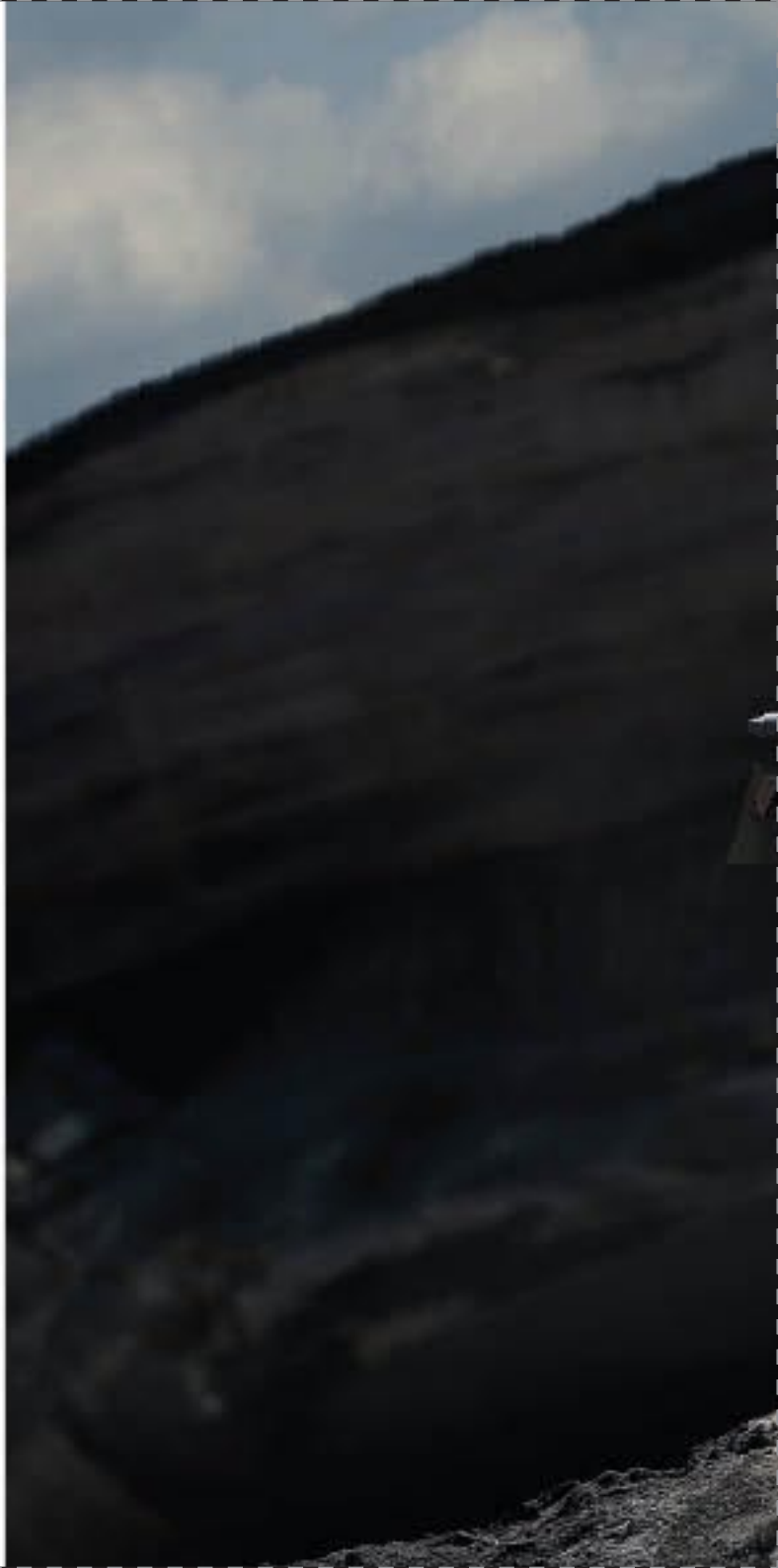
